

<p>Humber Students can sign up for Office 365 Education for free. Because it is cloud-based, you can work anywhere, anytime. The service includes familiar applications like Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and OneNote. 
Student Setup

Step 1: Click on the area that indicates you are a student.




Step 2: Fill out the information for your account and create a secure password.

Step 3: Launch a new browser and log into your Humbermail account and retrieve the email that has your verification code.

Step 4: Once you have your verification code, go back to the window where you were creating your account and enter the verification code. Click **Start**.





Step 5: Go through the welcome slides to get a quick tour of all the apps that are included in your Office 365 Education package. Or close the window and just jump right in.




First Time Logging in



Navigate to the website office.com and sign in with your humbermail email and the password you set up when you created your Office 365 Education account.



You will then see a window indicating more information is required. Humber has implemented a mandatory multi-factor authentication be set up.



To set up the multi-factor authentication you will need to supply a mobile number and a secondary email account (other than the humbermail.ca email you used to sign up).



A code will be sent to both your mobile and your email for you to enter/verify.
